THE MANHATTAN DECLARATION

The Manhattan Declaration is an interesting statement regarding abortion, marriage and religious liberty. The Declaration is the result of Eastern Orthodox, Anglican, catholic and Evangelical Christians uniting to reaffirm fundamental truths about justice and the common good. The fundamental truths pertain to 1) the sanctity of human life, 2) the dignity of marriage as the conjugal union of husband and wife, and 3) the rights of conscience and religious liberty.
