### St. Peter's Needy Association (SPNA) - April Report

For April, our total revenues were \$3,861.00 and total expenses were \$2,849.00. Our revenue was high because the contributions received for Holy Thursday amounted to \$1,984.00. Without Holy Thursday, our parish Outreach Program would have had a deficit. We thank you for using the SPNA (blue) envelopes which generated \$1,484.00. The remaining revenue of \$393.00 came from individual contributors who did not use the envelopes.

Again, rent assistance \$1,626.00 is our major expense, with eighteen persons receiving help. The remaining expenses by category were: food vouchers \$400.00, gas vouchers \$300.00; bus tickets \$222.00; utilities \$200.00; utilities \$200.00; storage \$100.00 and bank charges \$2.00.

With the current economic climate many persons cannot find employment or have been reassigned from full time to part time employment. Thus, the call for our emergency assistance Outreach Program has increased.
