### St. Peter's Needy Association: May Report

Our revenue for May totaled \$1,443.00 and our expenditures totaled \$3,750.70 – resulting in a monthly deficit of \$2,307.70. Our account balance for the year is \$3,700.00. Thus, we have funds to address emergency needs.

As in the past months rent assistance (\$1,894.70) is our largest expenditure with twenty people receiving assistance. In May, we had several requests for National Grid assistance with nine persons receiving a total of \$794.00.
